Community Space



- Serve as community centres
- Provide space for hosting knowledge sharing events such as conferences, seminars and workshops
- They can engage users in various physical creative activities, aiding them to built confidence
- Provide a personal identification of users
- Built social network of local people
- Public libraries help government to deliver citizen services
- The largest responsibility is to involve youngsters in knowledge activities and provide resources and reading space to help them reach career aspirations



Preservation of Cultural Heritage



Custodians of Cultural Heritage

- Maintaining and protecting physical materials such as rare books, manuscripts, and artefacts
- Guardians of historical and cultural knowledge

Specialized Preservation Techniques

- Conservation of rare materials often requires specialized preservation methods
- Hire skilled conservators to maintain the integrity of these invaluable items

Longevity of Rare Collections

- Uphold longevity of rare and valuable materials
- Protecting them from deterioration, damage and loss

Accessibility and Protection Balance

- Making them accessible to researchers and public
- Specialized viewing areas, digitization projects, and guided access protocols are employed

Diverse Cultural Events

- Libraries frequently host a variety of cultural events, such as author discussions, book readings
- Provide a platform for authors and artists to engage with the community

Educational Opportunities

- Educational workshops and lectures are regularly organized
- Providing continuous learning opportunities outside traditional classrooms

Community Engagement and Participation

- As community centres, encouraging local involvement through book clubs, discussion groups, and community projects
- Allow members to connect, share experiences, and learn from each other

Accessibility to Continuous Learning

- Breaking barriers of age, education, or socio-economic status
- Promoting lifelong learning and intellectual curiosity in a welcoming environment



Repositories of Unique Archives

- House exclusive archives, special collections, unique manuscripts, historical documents, and other items that are not typically found or accessible online

Vital Resource for Researchers and Scholars

- Researchers, scholars, and historians heavily rely on these physical libraries to access these rare and special materials for their work.

Preservation of Historical and Cultural Heritage

- Preservation of cultural and historical heritage through their archives and special collections
- Longevity and integrity of these materials, safeguarding them for future generations

Access to Specialized Materials

- Provide access to specialized materials that are often not digitized or widely available
- Access is important for studies in fields like history, literature, and the arts, where primary sources are invaluable.

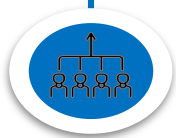

Assisting users in search strategies & providing guidance on using electronic databases, indexes, & other research tools



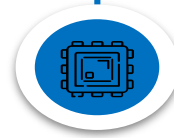
Interlibrary Loan Services

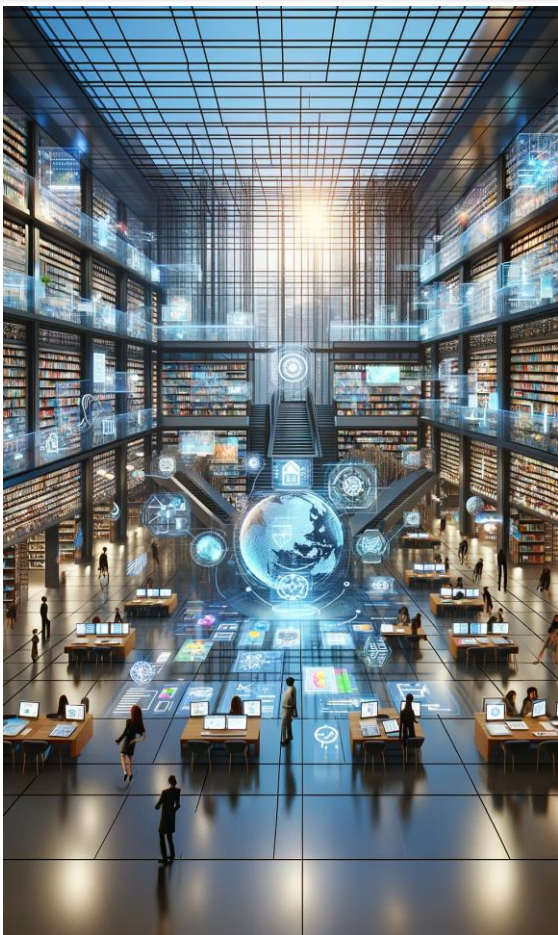

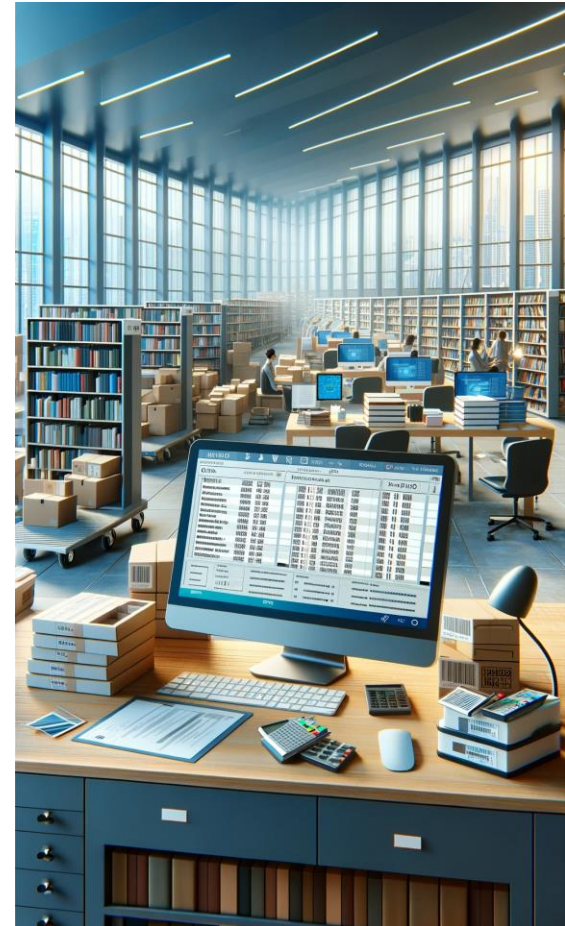
Not possible for individuals to purchase all type of books

Services in local languages

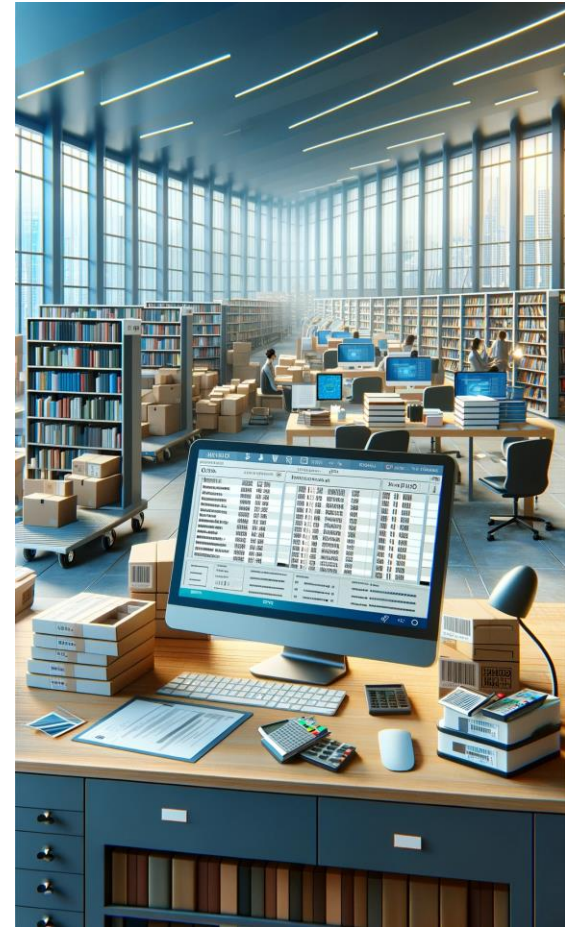

- Information about online education channels – SWAYAM PRABHA

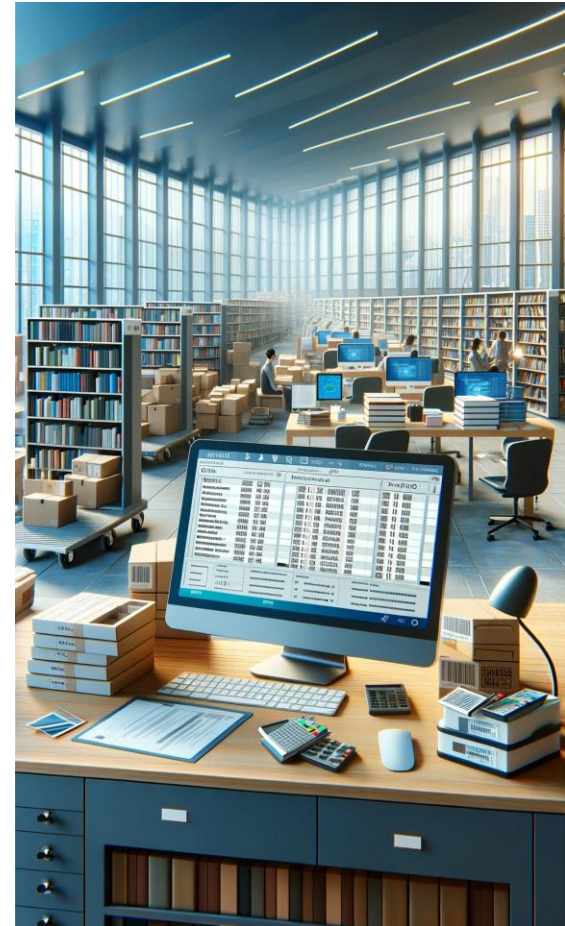


Library Extension Services
